Every cell that composes my body has an independent consciousness and soul—and half of those cells are non-human microbes. All these cells work together to create this body so that the singular soul that I think of as "me" can experience life in this dimension. And I am grateful!

If I feel an ache or pain, it is those cells communicating to me a need. I can listen and ask those cells what would help, or I can ignore and watch the pain grow stronger as the cells try to get my attention.

Doing energy work on a friend who recently had surgery to remove a bunion, I recognized that the cells on each side of the incision missed each other. So I drew energy pathways reconnecting them, to help them find each other physically and thus speed healing.

I then linked to the cells in the area where the bunion had been removed, and saw that they were in mourning—they missed their friends who were gone and never coming back. I let them know that I understood their loss, it was valid, I am sorry, and sent them love. (I did not tell them to "get over it, move on, just heal" as that does not relieve grief.)

This experience showed me that healers do not truly "take on" the illnesses of those they work with. Rather, the cells in our body are sympathizing with the cells in the body we are working with. When we lovingly help our cells release this sympathetic energy pattern, we will not experience the corresponding illness.

In a meditative state, I can link to all the consciousnesses of my body and feel us as ONE. Then we continue by linking this ONE consciousness to Earth-Gaia, and feel the oneness that comprises her and all the souls that reside in her purview. Next we link this oneness to our sun, Sol, and all the planets and moons revolving around him, and feel us as ONE—because we are also a single body. And we link to all the other similar bodies in our entire galaxy, and then all the galaxies in our universe, feeling the vastness of our unity. We now understand a small part of the love that comprises All That Is.
